

## Integrated Teacher Education Major Option (ITEP)

### Requirements:

Students must consult an [Academic Advisor](#) for specific program requirements.

A minimum GPA of 2.67 overall is required for enrollment in EDCI 4000.

Students must apply for admission to the Charter College of Education the semester before enrolling in EDCI 4000.

Before being formally admitted to the credential program, students must meet the Basic Skills Requirement, hold a Certificate of Clearance, and pass a Writing Intensive (WI) course and Graduate Writing Assessment Requirement (if an international student) with a grade of C or better. Students should see a major advisor regarding completion of the degree and other credential requirements.

### For students in **Chicana(o) and Latina(o) Studies, B.A. or Liberal Studies, B.A.:**

Completion of the ITEP option qualifies students to be eligible for an intern credential with verification of employment from a cooperating school district. To receive a Preliminary Education Specialist Credential, students complete additional credential coursework and all CTC requirements in their area of specialization, i.e., Mild to Moderate Support Needs (MMSN), Extensive Support Needs (ESN), or Visual Impairments (VI).

### Students in **Urban Learning, B.A. (Option 2-MMSN/ESN and Option 3):**

Completion of all CTC credential requirements will be eligible for the Preliminary Education Specialist Credential. Students in Option 2-VI will be eligible for an intern credential with verification of employment from a cooperating school district. To receive the Preliminary Education Specialist Credential in VI, students must complete additional VI credential coursework and all CTC requirements.
